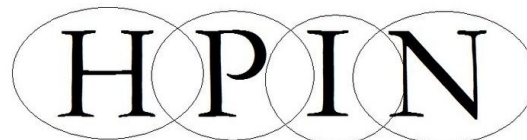

Family Promise is a family emergency shelter for parents with children. They provide shelter, food, and case management services. Adults are screened prior to admission and must pass a criminal history background check and a drug screen. Services are offered for 30 days.

## ***Emergency Shelter for Victims of Domestic Violence***

The YWCA provides a safe, confidential emergency shelter for women and their children who are victims of domestic violence. The shelter operates 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Clients staying at the shelter receive case management with the goal of finding employment, housing, legal resources, financial resources, childcare, counseling, etc.

They offer free support groups for self-esteem, parenting and conflict resolution.
